Assalaamu aluykoom Respected Parent/Guardian,

Re – Fees (Summer Term 2020)

In these unprecedented times, I pray that you, your children and families are in good health and Eemaan. Ameen.

You will no doubt appreciate the huge challenges faced by those tasked with the responsibility of managing Afifah School. Our greatest difficulty is finding a financial solution that will satisfy the competing demands of parents, students, staff and the long-term future of the school. We have always worked in partnership with parents and fully appreciate that we will have to reconsider our fee structure, in light of the Coronavirus pandemic.

Consequently, in order to provide some reassurance to parents, the trustees have decided ;

- All parents must have paid the fees that were due for the end of the Spring Term (5 April 2020) by **Friday 17 April 2020**.
- There will be a **67% reduction / discount of fees for the Summer Term** (20 April 2020 to 16 July 2020). This means that you will **only pay 33% of the fees due for the Summer Term**. These reduced fees must be paid by **Monday 1 June 2020**, so that we do not have a cash-flow problem thereafter.
- This generous reduction / discount is only applicable for the Summer 2020 term and is **subject to us receiving the appropriate funding from the Government**.
- A credit will be allocated for the new academic year 2020/21 for those who have already paid the fees in full.
- Students will continue with their online learning.
- In the event that the Government requests schools to re-open during the Summer term, the reduced / discounted fee structure will end and the standard fee structure will be re-introduced.

We believe Afifah provides a unique holistic education to our next generation. This needs to continue after the pandemic has subsided. We do not want even one child to be deprived of the Islamic education that we offer.

Please be rest assured that I have done (and will continue to do) everything within my power to minimise the financial burden on parents during these difficult times. I am confident that you will support the school, so that we are ready to re-open once it is safe to do so. Kindly remember the whole school community, Ummah and humanity in your supplications. May Allah SWT keep us all under his protection. Ameen
