SCHOOL FEES POLICY



Every pupil will pay:

- Annual School Fees
- Admission Fees
- External Examination Fees
- Deposits against text books
- Educational Trips
- Uniform

PRACTICE

- Being an independent school every pupil has to pay the annual school fees, as decided by the Chair of Governors & The Board of Trustees in April for the forthcoming academic year. (Instalment and direct debit facility is available)
- School Fees will be paid over 10 months (Sept – June) and by the 8th day of each month. If this is not possible, the parent/guardian must inform the office and pay by the 15th day of the month. If the monthly fees are not paid by the 15th of the month the parent/guardian must discuss the matter with the Head Teacher, otherwise the school office will escalate the matter to the appointed Governor.
- For every new admission there will be an Admission Fee charged (payable before the student's first day at school).
- Year 11 students will pay the full annual fees, even though they will leave school in June.
- In addition to this, the school levies charges for books purchased, deposits for books that are hired for the year (50% of which is returned at the end of the year), uniform materials and equipments provided in connection with the National Curriculum.
- The school levies charge for external examinations entry, which goes to the respected awarding bodies. In addition to this there will be a minimum charge of £30 per student per annum for the administration work.
- The school requests voluntary contributions from parents for activities in school time for which compulsory charges cannot be levied (Tuck Days).
- The school seeks payment, on an old for -new basis, from parents for damage or loss of school property caused wilfully or negligently by their children.
- All fees will be subject to annual review.
- Any changes in fees will be communicated to parents at least three months before the change is implemented.
